Coop developing a new goods terminal in Eskilstuna Logistics Park

Coop's new goods terminal will be one of Sweden's largest automated solutions and will provide over 400 jobs when it is fully operational during the second half of 2024.

With its 276,000 square metre site and a building of 109,000 square metres, the new terminal in Eskilstuna will be one of the country's largest food terminals, delivering goods to all of Coop's 800 shops.

The terminal will be a fully-automated facility with heights from 15 metres up to 36 metres, where all processes, from reception of goods to picking onto pallets, will be automated and will take place around the clock.

"We feel that Coop's future competitiveness

sustainability when more transports go by rail", says Magnus Johansson, CEO of Coop Sweden.

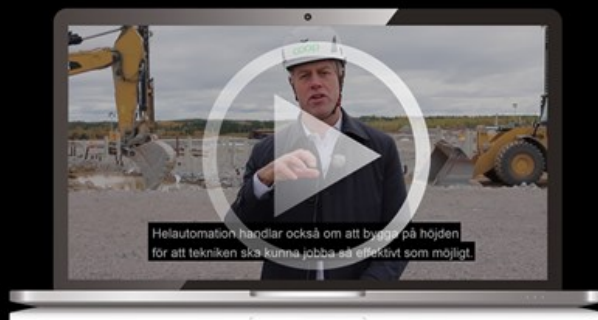
Around 35% of Coop's transports already go by rail. Coop is going to build two 1 kilometre long train tracks for its own use on the new site in the logistics park, where its 600 metre long goods trains can load and unload several times per day, enabling the company to expand the proportion of train transports.

The establishment means that over 400 new
